| Project Overview                         | <p>Plantation, woodchip , log and wood pellet &amp; sales and (Acacia , Eucalyptus)<br/>KTH received 43-year-industrial forest plantation concession right (~90,000ha) in 1998 and started planting Acacia and Eucalyptus.<br/>Harvesting began in 2011 and logs were sold to domestic markets. The company built Industrial Wood Processing Complex in 2013 and started processing woodchips for Oji Group. It also began selling forest residue pellet in 2017.<br/>KTH also has been promoting local development and forest resources expansion with community forests (~4,000ha) by local residents.</p>  |  |                     |
