In 2007, 36 years after the estblishment in 1971, Pan Pac became a fully owned subsidiary of Oji Holdings Limited.

We had specialized to supply pulp to Shareholders in Japan at first, then shifting and expanding export business of BCTMP, log and lumber to worldwide market.

In December 2014 we established a subsidiary company, Pan Pac Forest Products (Otago) Limited, a lumber business which operates a modern sawmill, boiler, continuous kiln and drymill from a site at Milburn just south of Dunedin in the South Island.
